ORDER GRANTING EXPUNCTION OF RECORD

THIS CAUSE came on for consideration of Defendant's *Ore Tenus* Petition Requesting Expunction of Record and the Court being satisfied that it has jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter hereby FINDS, ORDERS and ADJUDGES that:

1.

The Defendant was arrested for criminal charges and was released and the charges were dropped or there was no disposition and this Court hereby orders the expunction of all of the following records of the arrest and all other matters stemming from said arrest of Defendant, together with all other records maintained by the Justice Court Clerk of Rankin County, Mississippi; the Office of the Sheriff of Rankin County, Brandon, Mississippi; Mississippi Department of Corrections, Jackson, Mississippi; Mississippi Department of Public Safety, Criminal Information Center, Jackson, Mississippi; United States Department of Justice, Washington D.C.; Federal Bureau of Investigation, Jackson, Mississippi; and any and all other governmental agencies and law enforcement agencies and courts of the State of Mississippi:

The effect of this Order shall be to restore such person, in the contemplation of the law, to the status he/she occupied before such arrest. No person as to whom such order has been entered shall be held thereafter under any provision of law to be guilty of perjury or to have otherwise given a false statement by reason of his/her failure to recite or acknowledge such arrest or conviction in response to any inquiry made of him/her for any purpose, except for the purpose of determining in any subsequent proceedings under this section, whether such person is a first offender.
